It's time to put your talent to use by revising the St. John's College school song – *St. John's College March*, known more familiarly as *St. John's Forever*. Adrian Trevisan, A84, and Claiborne Booker, A84, have offered A CASH PRIZE OF \$1,696 to the winning composition of new verses for this song.

On the centenary of the *St. John's College March* (written in 1911 by an SJC alumnus, R. Graham Moss), the Trevisan-Booker Prize will go to whoever updates its lyrics to make our school song more relevant to the Program. The updated version should be suitable for a new *a capella* vocal arrangement for four-part SATB chorus. The Trevisan-Booker Prize committee has agreed to offer A CASH PRIZE of \$848 for the arrangement. The competition is open to submissions in any form (video/audio presentation, written, e-mailed), but the winning entry must be transcribed into musical notation.
