Enclosed are:

1. **Schedule of Registration Events and Academic Year Calendar.**
2. **General Information Leaflet:** This leaflet contains general information concerning your first classes, clothing and supplies, payment of fees, mailing address at the College, dormitories, and computers.
3. **Letter from Dean and Assistant Dean:** This letter outlines the college's policies with respect to the illegal use and the misuse of alcohol and drugs.

The following materials are available online and should be downloaded, completed, and returned to the appropriate office in the envelopes provided in this packet. The materials can be accessed by going to the college's web site (www.stjohnscollege.edu) and following either of these paths:

Musical Background Form: This information will be used to schedule Freshman Chorus. Please complete and submit it online as soon as possible.

Housing Questionnaire: The Assistant Dean's office needs the information on this form to help them make better roommate matches. This should be submitted online by August 1. You should be notified of your room assignment in the first week of August.

Health Center Packet: Please download this packet, which includes a medical history form to be filled out by your physician. After completing these forms, return via US mail in the envelope provided, addressed to the Director of Student Health.

Disabilities Forms: If you have a disability or other condition that you think may require accommodation by the College, whether with your housing needs, academic needs, or in some other arena, you must submit the required forms and documentation. You may submit them online or download and return them via US mail in the Health Center Envelope. The Assistant Dean is the Americans with Disabilities Act coordinator for the College.

Registration Packet: This packet includes forms for the Registrar and Admissions Office. Download and complete these forms and return via US mail in the envelope provided, addressed to the Registrar.

PLEASE NOTE: AT THE VERY LATEST, THE ITEMS IN THE HEALTH CENTER PACKET AND THE REGISTRATION PACKET, PLUS THE ONLINE MUSICAL BACKGROUND FORM, MUST BE PRESENTED ON REGISTRATION DAY. NO STUDENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENROLL WITHOUT THEM. YOUR REGISTRATION, HOWEVER, WILL BE MUCH FASTER AND EASIER IF YOU COMPLETE THESE MATERIALS AND RETURN THEM TO US AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. APPROPRIATE ENVELOPES HAVE BEEN PROVIDED FOR YOUR USE.

The bill for your tuition and fees will be sent well in advance of registration. Included with the bill will be information about various payment plans and health insurance.

Your parents will be receiving an invitation to the orientation activities we hold for them on registration day. These activities are our attempt to help them understand what you will be doing at St. John's. It is important that your parents understand and support your undertaking here. We have found that the opportunity to talk with tutors, students, and administrators is a welcome one for most parents.
