In order to provide you with the most comprehensive health care possible, we at the Counseling Center, ask you to consider the following suggestions.

1. If you have a learning disability that has been diagnosed for accommodation in high school and for which you take medication, we ask that you contact the Counseling Center before you arrive. We can be reached at bernadette.zorio@sjca.edu or 410-626-2552. Prescriptions must be monitored by a physician. The Counseling Center can provide a list of local psychiatrists to assist you, or you may choose to continue working with your current health-care provider. Documentation of learning accommodation plans should be forwarded to the office of the Assistant Dean.
2. Students who have other pre-existing conditions requiring psychotropic medication must contact the Counseling Center to ensure proper support and follow-up. Counselors provide referral and supportive counseling services for students on a regular basis.
